The Red Lion Hotel DOES NOT permit people to "camp" in or out of their vehicles in the hotel parking lot. The hotel's "security" will monitor the parking lot at night and disrupt anyone sleeping in their vehicle. There is an RV Park about a mile down the road from the hotel.

Meals

The Saturday night banquet is included in registration fees. Saturday's lunch will be a deli buffet; FM underwrites lunch as part of our room contract. SPEAKERS

Dr. Anthony R. Kampf, Curator and Department Head, Mineral Sciences, Natural History Museum of Los Angeles County. Dr. Kampf, who received his Ph.D. from the University of Chicago in 1976, is in charge of the Museum's collection of minerals and gems, ranked 4th in importance in the U.S. and 1st west of Washington D.C. He conducts research in descriptive mineralogy and structural crystallography, and has published more than 140 scientific and popular papers and articles, including the descriptions of 22 new minerals. He has a special interest in gem-bearing pegmatite deposits, especially those in Southern California and Brazil. He has traveled extensively and led 13 tours to the gem and mineral deposits of Minas Gerais, Brazil.

Scott Werschky, Mineral Dealer (Miner's Lunchbox) did his undergraduate and masters work in geology and geochemistry at the University of Colorado. He was an exploration geologist with USGS, Anaconda and FMC Gold and became a full time dealer in 1996, although he still consults occasionally. Scott has made over 50 buying trips to Peru.

David Waisman received his B.S. from Colorado State and his M.S. from the University of Montana and has over 16 years of experience in base and precious metals exploration. He is presently working with an environmental testing lab serving the gold and copper mining industry. He is the founder of the Westward Look Mineral Show, a satellite show at the February Tucson Gem and Mineral Show focusing on fine minerals. He has been to Brazil 15 times in quest of gems and mineral specimens.
