## SPEAKERS

**Dr. Virgil W. Lueth, Socorro, New Mexico** has been Mineralogist/Economic Geologist and Curator of the Mineral Museum at the New Mexico Bureau of Mines and Mineral Resources since 1994. He received his B.S. at the Univ. of Wisconsin – Eau Claire and his Ph.D. from the Univ. of Texas at El Paso. Virgil served on the Boards of Directors of the Society of Mineral Museum Professionals, the New Mexico Geological Society and FM. He is currently the President of FM. Virgil has chaired the New Mexico Mineral Symposium for the last 10 years.

**Joe Marty, Salt Lake City, Utah**, is an active field collector of Southwest minerals. He is a retired medical technologist and maintains a business cleaning and servicing microscopes. Joe was recently inducted into the Micromounters Hall of Fame, and he has a collection of over 10,000 catalogued micromounts.

**Allan Young** is a mining engineer who has built or managed mines in Colorado, Idaho, and Nevada, and has directed mining in Utah and California. He currently works with the Bureau of Land Management. Since 1983 he has collected thumbnails, and has won both the Desautels and Lidstrom trophies. His collection includes about 1,000 specimens, with emphasis on silver-bearing and Idaho minerals. He began working with digital photography in mid-2005.
