MEETING RESCHEDULED FOR SATURDAY, JUNE 11TH

DUE TO SCHEDULING CONFLICTS, the June meeting of the PNWFM will be June 11th at 1 p.m. on the campus of Western Washington University. The originally scheduled June 4th meeting has been cancelled. We will meet in one of the mineralogy classrooms, enjoy a short program, then wander the halls looking at the many displays of Northwest geology, including minerals, fossils, and rock types. George Mustoe, the keeper of the equipment in the department, will be on hand to demonstrate various SEMs, microscopes, and other lab equipment.

DIRECTIONS: Take the Bill McDonald Parkway-Samish Way exit 252 from I-5 at south Bellingham. Follow the Parkway up around the south side of Sehome hill past the High School and take the first right up College Drive. Turn right on East Campus Way. Take the second driveway into the parking lot. You can park at a meter or buy a ticket for your car. The ticket is cheaper at \$1/ hour. This is the only campus in Washington that charges for parking on weekends. A parking ticket from the U costs \$20. A free parking lot is the large gravel lot on the right of College Drive, next to Fairhaven College. You would then have to walk ¼ mile up to the ESC building.

When you enter the building, please look for a flyer indicating the room number for the meeting.

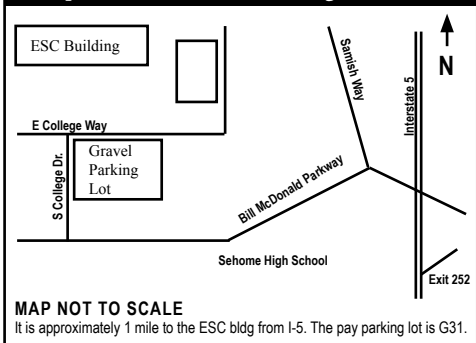
